



Everly House Activities

This month I'm going to share a little bit about the different activities we have going on at the Everly House. You can refer to our calendar to see what times the activities start. Every weekday morning we have chair exercises available to participate in. On Monday mornings we also alternate trips to Walmart and the Hobby Lobby strip mall. On Monday afternoons we play Bingo. On Tuesdays Bunco is played in the Sunroom and the game, Two Dice-Two Bingos, is played in the afternoon. On Wednesdays we usually have a Christian fellowship after exercise and then play the Frog Race dice game after that. Wednesday afternoons are usually reserved for crafts, recycling cards, or musical guests. The crafts created are used to decorate our bulletin boards or for parties. On Thursdays we have Bunco in the morning and Bingo in the afternoon. Friday mornings we usually have our Horse Race dice game. Friday afternoons are open to freelance activities. People can get together and play any game of their choice, or they can paint, color or whatever they choose

to do. We usually have our monthly party on one of the Friday afternoons. Once the weather gets nice, we will be going out of town to lunch once a month, plant flowers, and have Friday afternoon trips to get ice cream. On Friday evenings several residents get together to watch a movie in the Activity Room. On Saturday mornings a few women gather for adult coloring. Their projects are displayed on the bulletin boards, and they also color the name tags for the dining room each month. Saturday afternoons host another Bingo game. Bingo seems to be a favorite activity among our residents. On Sundays, local churches and volunteers lead a Bible fellowship in the afternoon. We call this gathering Vespers. We are very appreciative of them and of all our thoughtful volunteers. In the Fall we celebrate Friends and Family night. Throughout the year, we also host other holiday parties and activities such as our Elf Party, a Candlelight Dinner, a Christmas Lights Drive, and a New Years Eve Party.

None of the activities at the Everly House are set in stone, they change monthly as needed. We are always open to new ideas and suggestions. This is your home so feel free to get together with friends and family to play games, watch movies, or do activities on your own.
